Phonics Mini-Bites is a program designed for young learners to acquire English reading skills easily and quickly. Each unit introduces a set of four letters along with their corresponding phonetic sounds. These letters are then used to construct four words, which are further reinforced and practiced through engaging reading, writing, and fun activities.

How to Use This Book

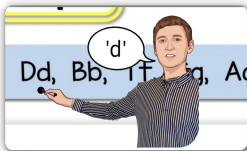
Each unit of this book contains a new word section, letter tracing, listening, and reading. The new words section introduces the Phonics Bites group and new words that are practiced throughout the unit.

For every section, there is a 'Repetitions' box. When the child completes the section, you can mark it with a sticker, a happy face, or a star. For sections involving writing, you can either erase the pencil marks to do it again or place the papers in plastic sleeves and use dry-erase markers for reusability.

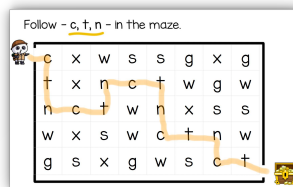
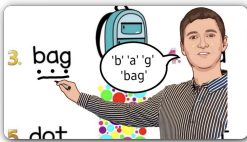


1 New Words

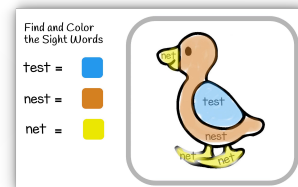
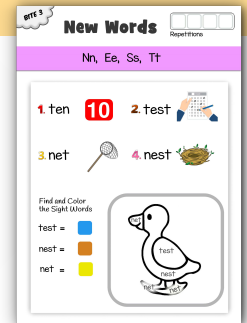
Begin by pointing to each letter and saying its name. Have kids repeat after you. After practicing the letter names, point to each letter again and say the letter's sound.



Read each word aloud. Begin by pointing to each letter and articulating its sound. Then, read the word and draw a line underneath it, symbolizing the sounds blending together. Learners should say the sounds along with you.



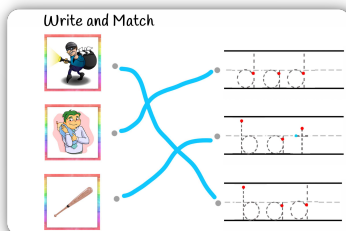
Children follow the letters through the maze to help panda find the treasure!



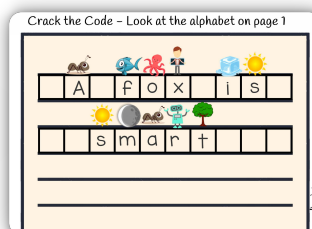
Give kids the three colors shown. Kids then color the picture by finding the words and matching the colors.

2 Letter Tracing

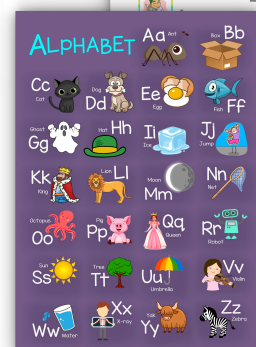
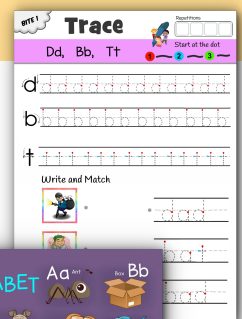
Children follow the diagram and practice writing lowercase letters.

Children look at the alphabet poster to find the correct letters to write and solve the secret message!

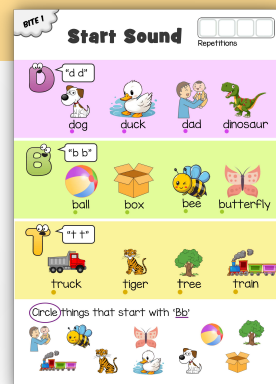
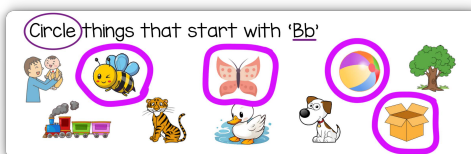


3 Start Sounds

Begin by pointing to the character letter and say the name. Then repeat the sound of the letter twice before saying each word. Repeat for each letter.

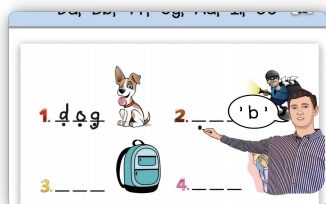

Circle the pictures of the words that start with the target letter.

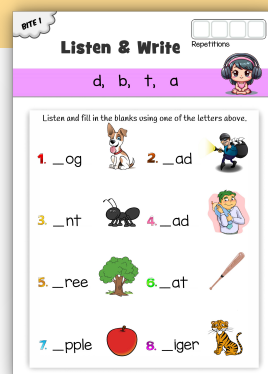


4 Listen & Write

Start by practicing or reviewing the letter sounds in the same manner as in Section 1 (New Words).
